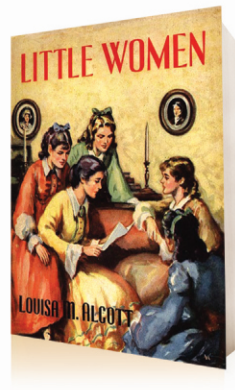
The Witch of Blackbird Pond
